



COMMUNITY/SCHOOL DRESS CODE SY 2008 – 2009

The United States Army Garrison (USAG) Schweinfurt in coordination with Schweinfurt Elementary School supports a community initiated school dress code. All items that are part of the dress code will be stocked by AAFES. The optional items may or may not be part of their stock. All clothing will be clean, neat, serviceable (no holes, tears, slits deliberately cut, frayed or ragged), worn properly, and fit appropriately. Families new to the school will have a grace period of two weeks to obtain specified school dress code clothing items.

There may be times when exceptions are granted by the school administration. The following are some examples:

- ❖ School Picture Day
- ❖ Unit T-Shirt Day
- ❖ Student-Choice Dress Day
- ❖ Study Trips (Field Trips)
- ❖ Special Classroom Theme Days

If you do not find the items you need at AAFES, it is suggested that you express your concerns to AAFES management. The Schweinfurt Community Thrift Shop also carries school clothing items. Appropriate school clothing items are also available online at: target.com; jcpenny.com; walmart.com; frenchtoast.com.

The adopted Community/School Dress Code is mandatory. Each student will be required to wear the prescribed clothing while attending Schweinfurt Elementary School. Any issue which cannot be resolved between the Schweinfurt Elementary School Principal and parents will be elevated to the USAG Schweinfurt Commander and/or the School's Officer for further evaluation.

The following procedures are an outline of the steps to be followed to notify and assist families in complying with the community/school dress code. The intent is to work with sponsors to ensure successful compliance. Students will be sent to the nurse for replacement clothing only if the violation causes disruption to learning or poses a safety hazard for the student. The nurse will notify the front office. Administration will then determine if notification of the sponsor is necessary and the appropriate action to be taken.

STEP 2	Classroom Teacher	Contact sponsor by phone or in writing
STEP 3	Administration	Contact sponsor by phone or in writing
STEP 4	Administration & School Liaison Officer	Contact sponsor's Unit Command
STEP 5	Administration & School Liaison Officer	Contact USAG Schweinfurt Command
